SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL- GRADES: 10-12

The Civics Pacing Guide is a projected guide to assist students' progress and expected outcomes. Students will learn about citizenship and democratic principles. The document covers grades 10-12 and teachers are not expected to cover the content in the order it is presented. It is recommended that teachers use the document to meet specific needs of students.

Course Description:

Students demonstrate critical thinking and argumentative skills that reflect civics engagement and participation.

Students demonstrate that they are able to work collaboratively and be engaged in discussions which collectively, provides involvement in group participation.

Students will demonstrate that they understand their role as citizens in a country.

Prerequisites: Students must be enrolled in grades 10, 11 and 12 at a public high school.

In order for students to achieve great success in this course, it is strongly recommended that all persons enrolled in this course be willing to participate in discussions and group activities.
